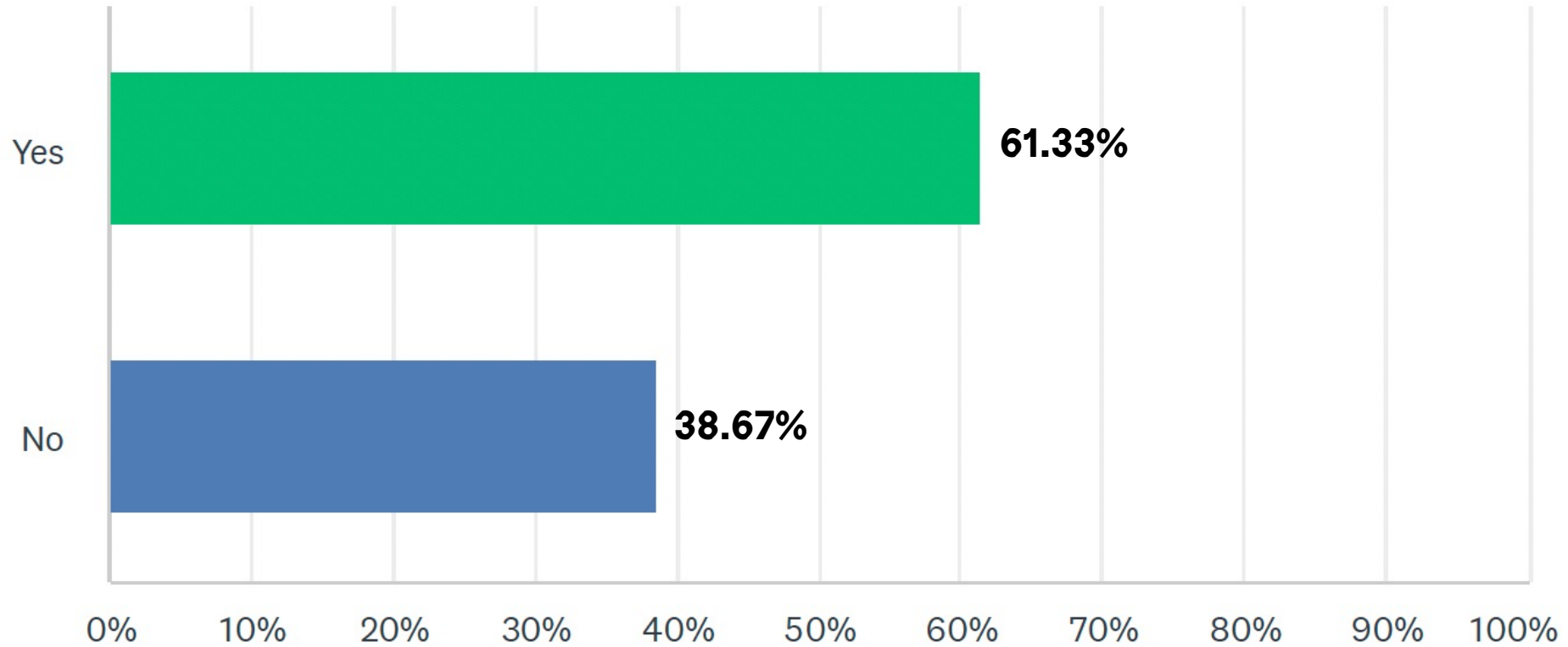

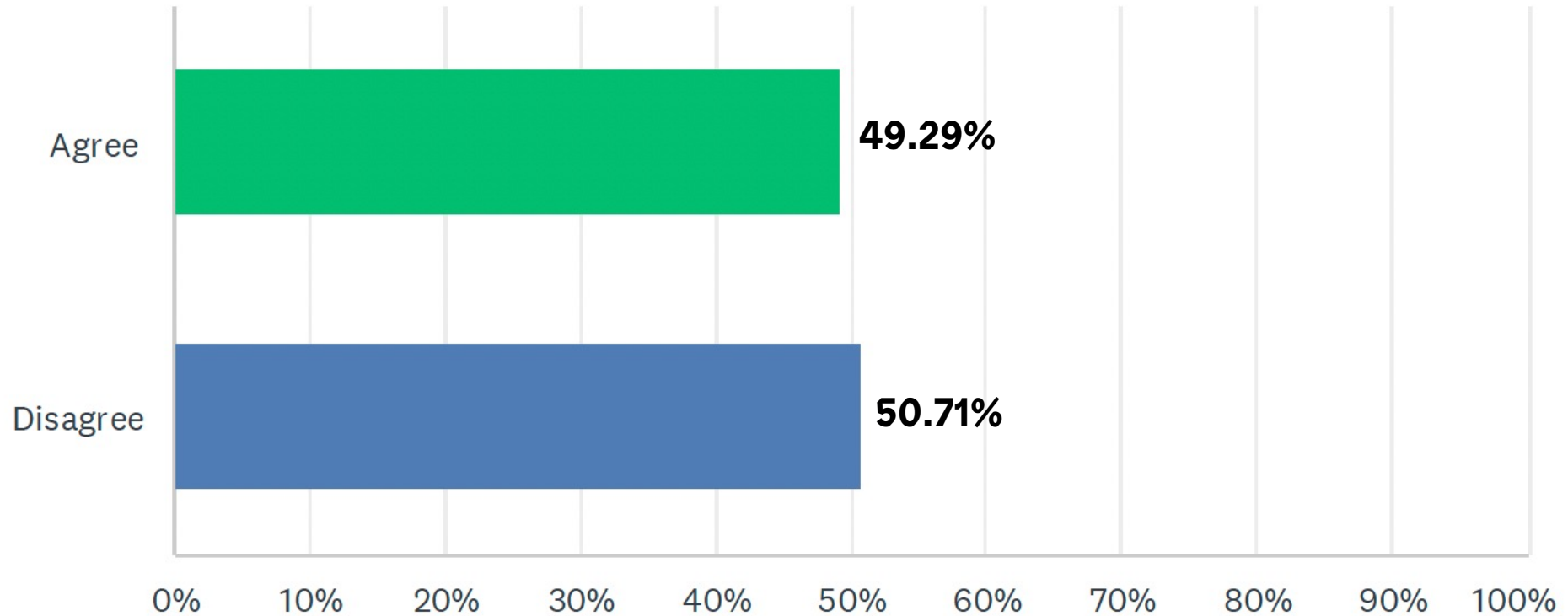

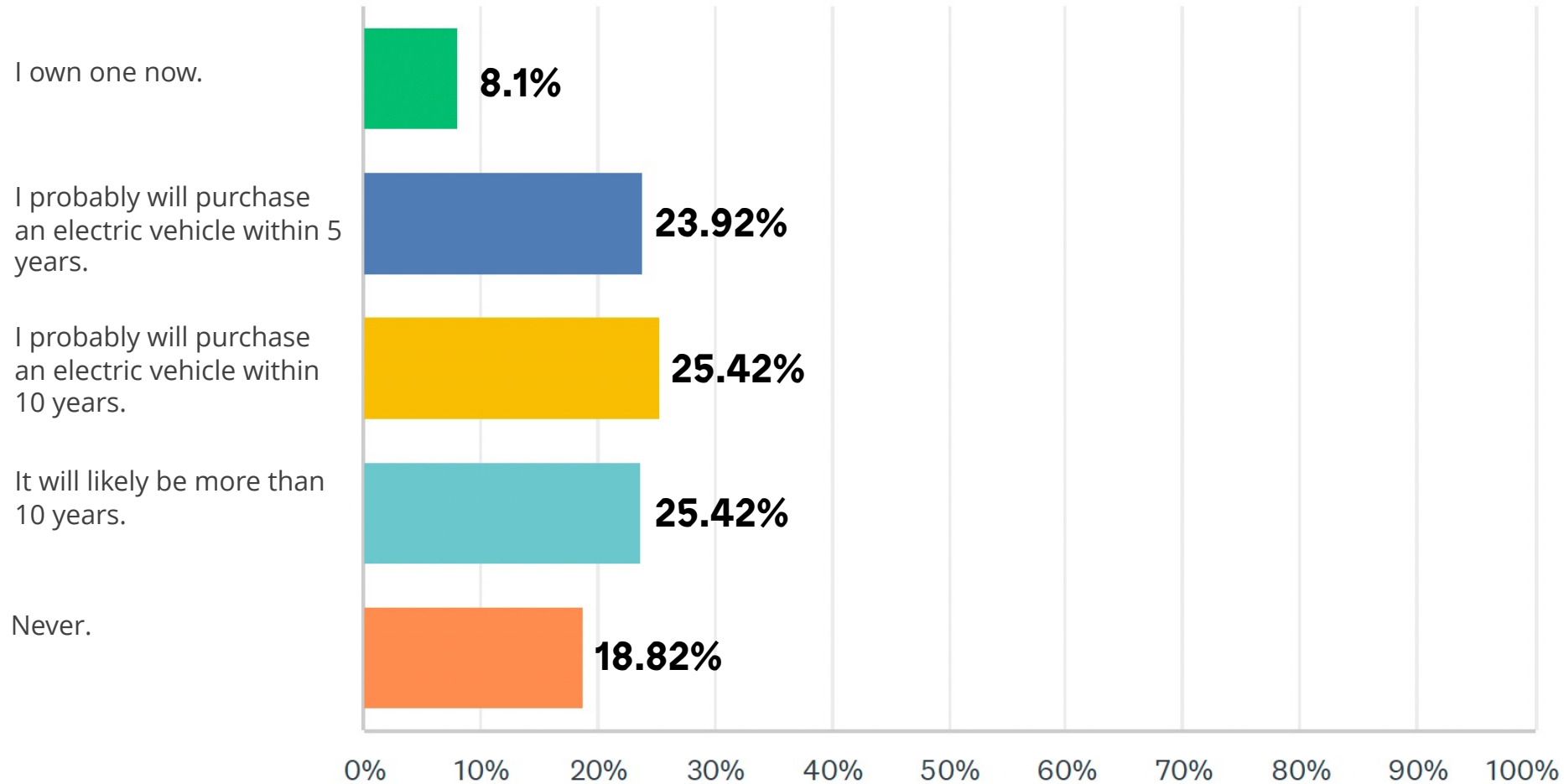

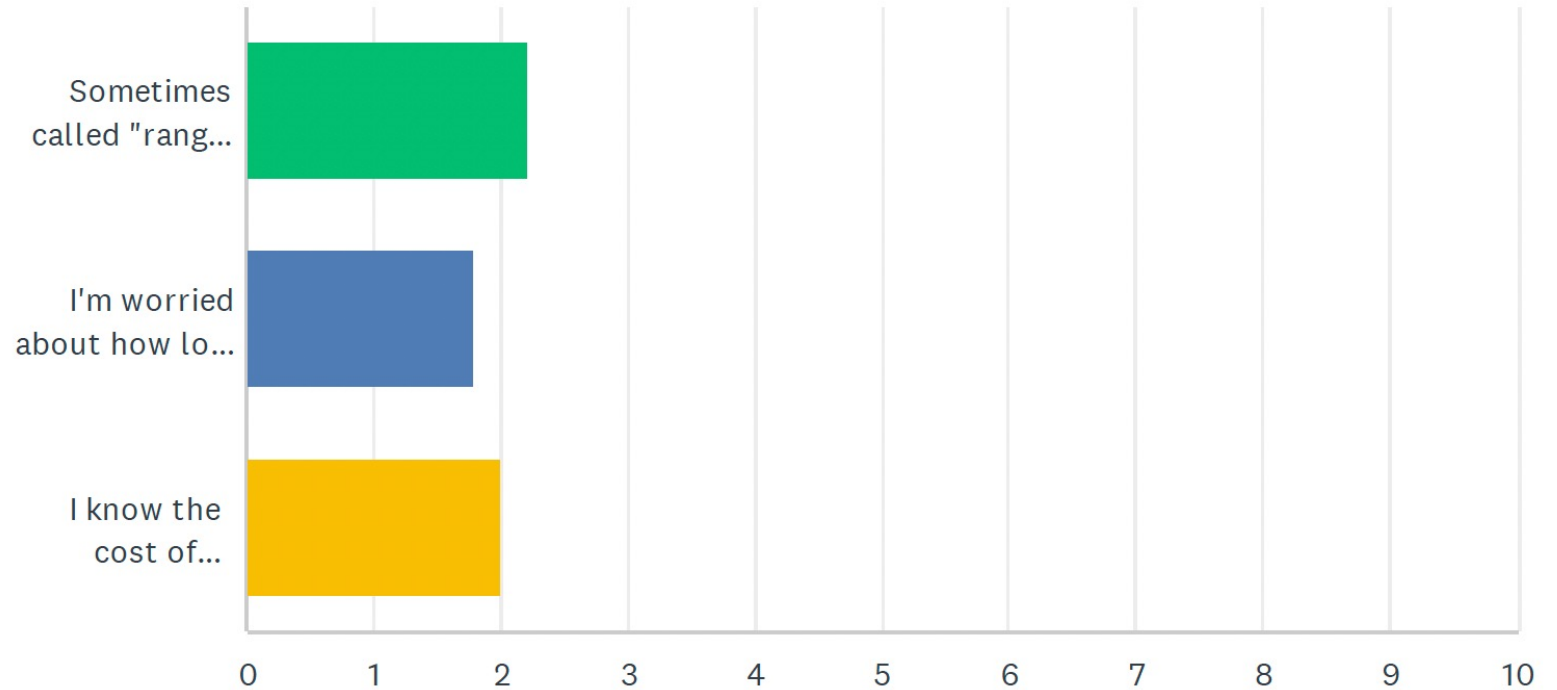

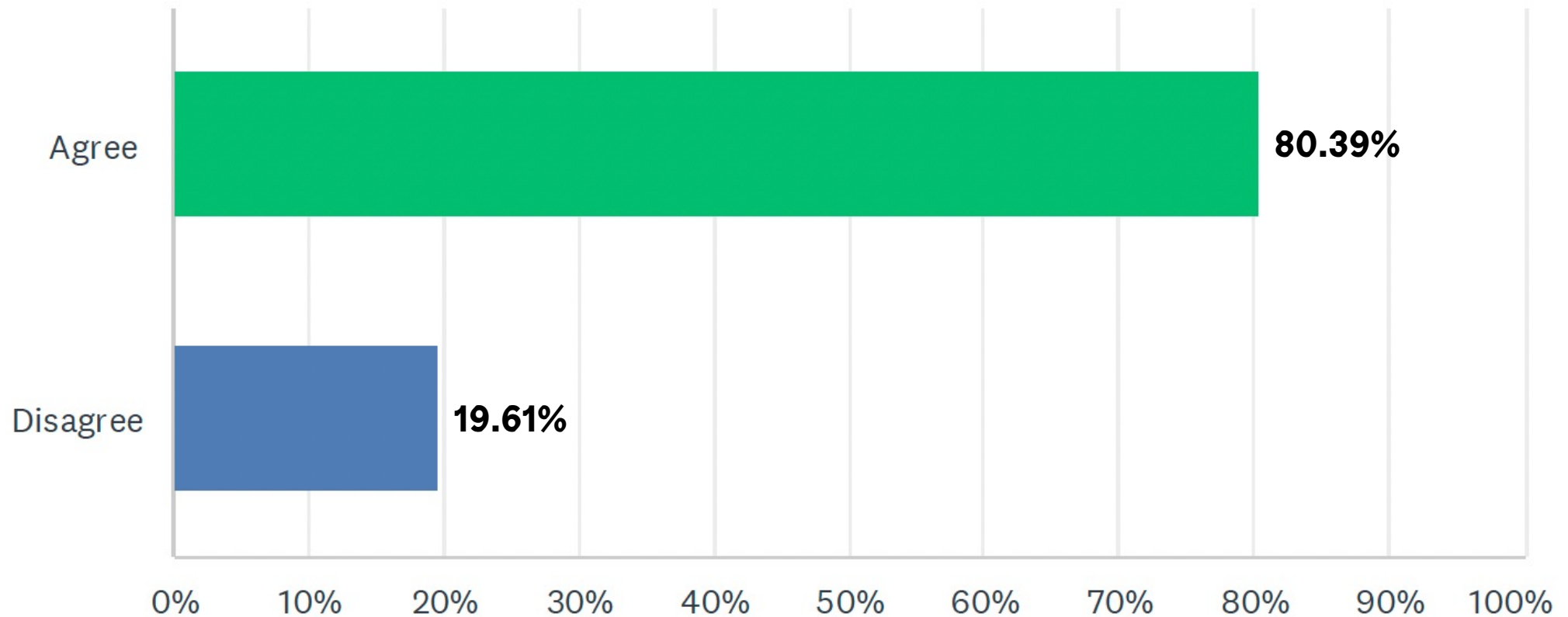

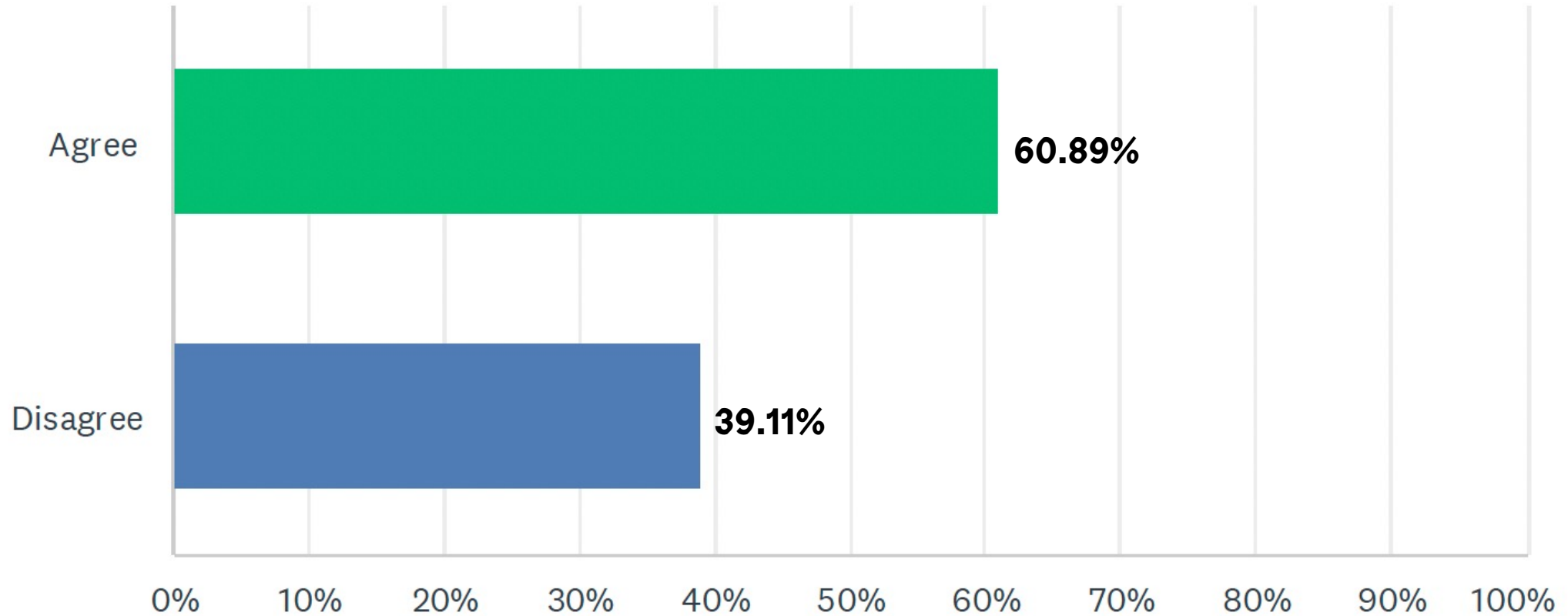

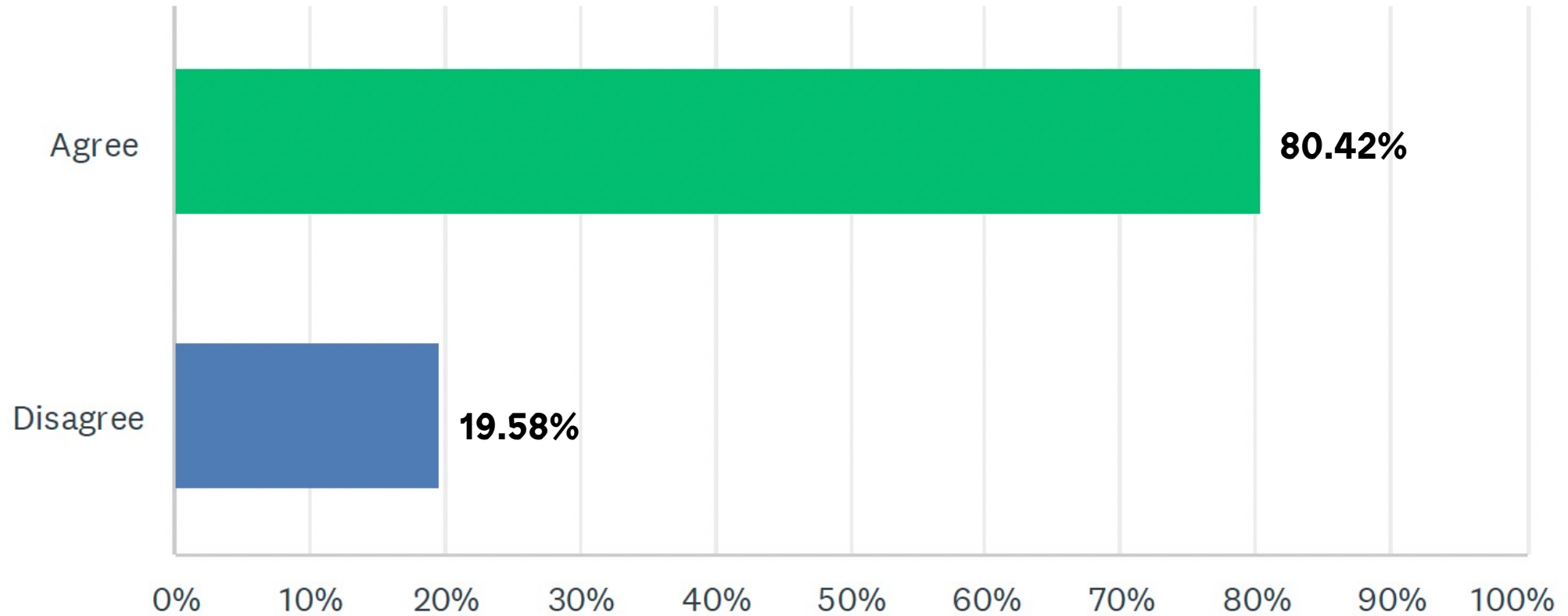

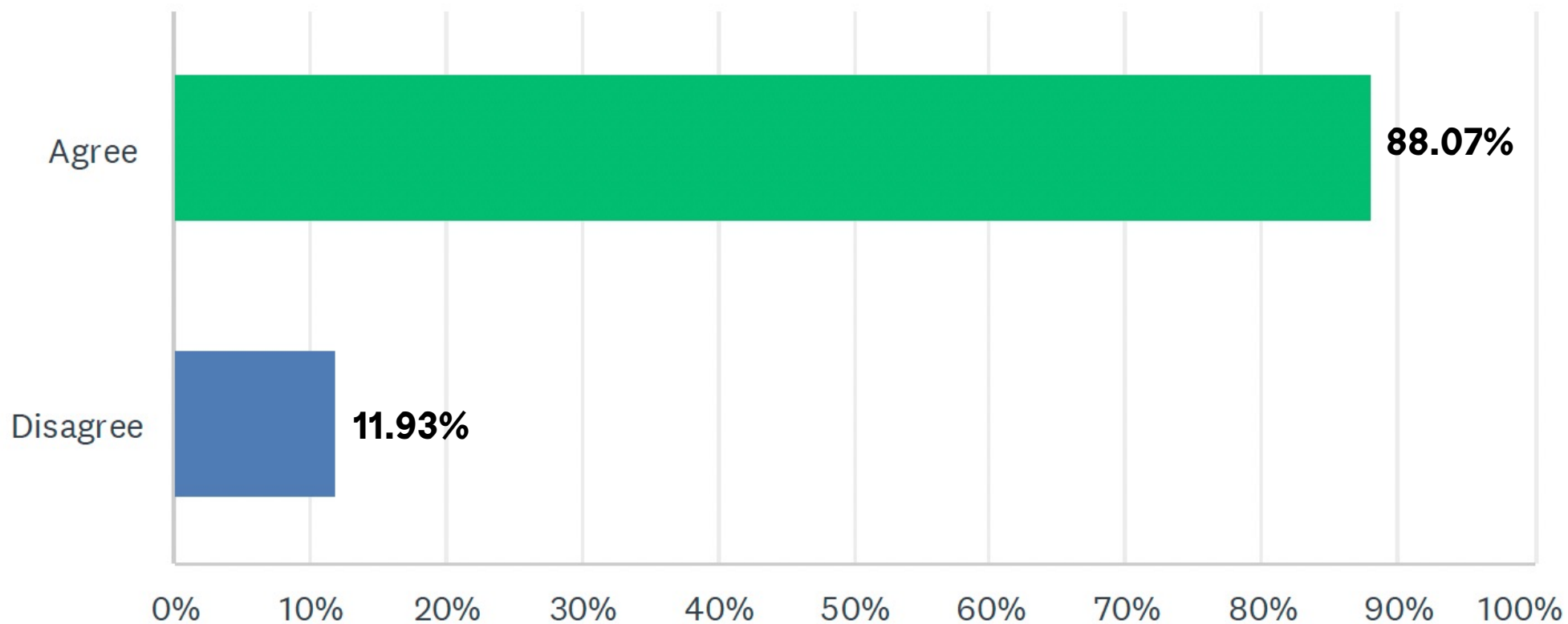

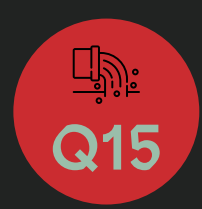




Is your home served by a public water supply or groundwater well?

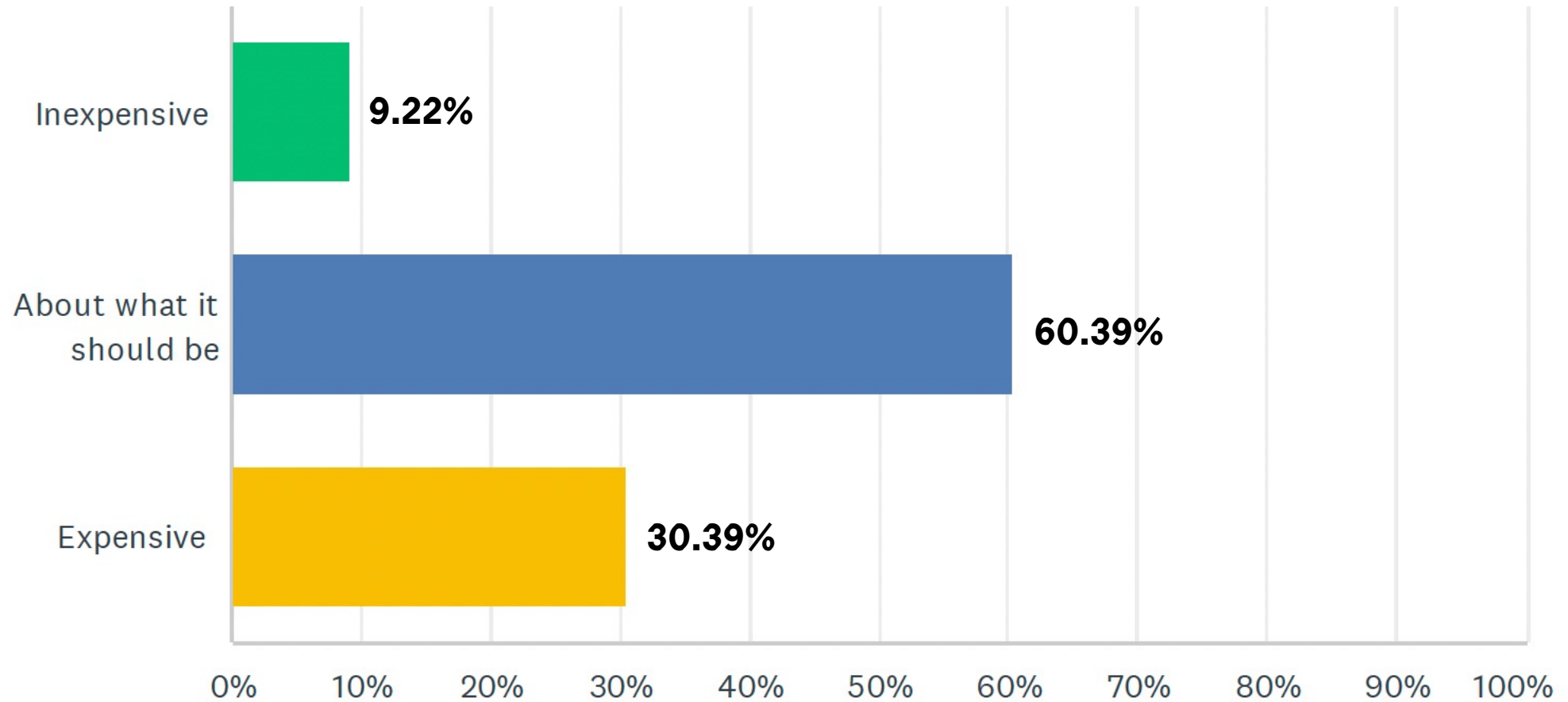

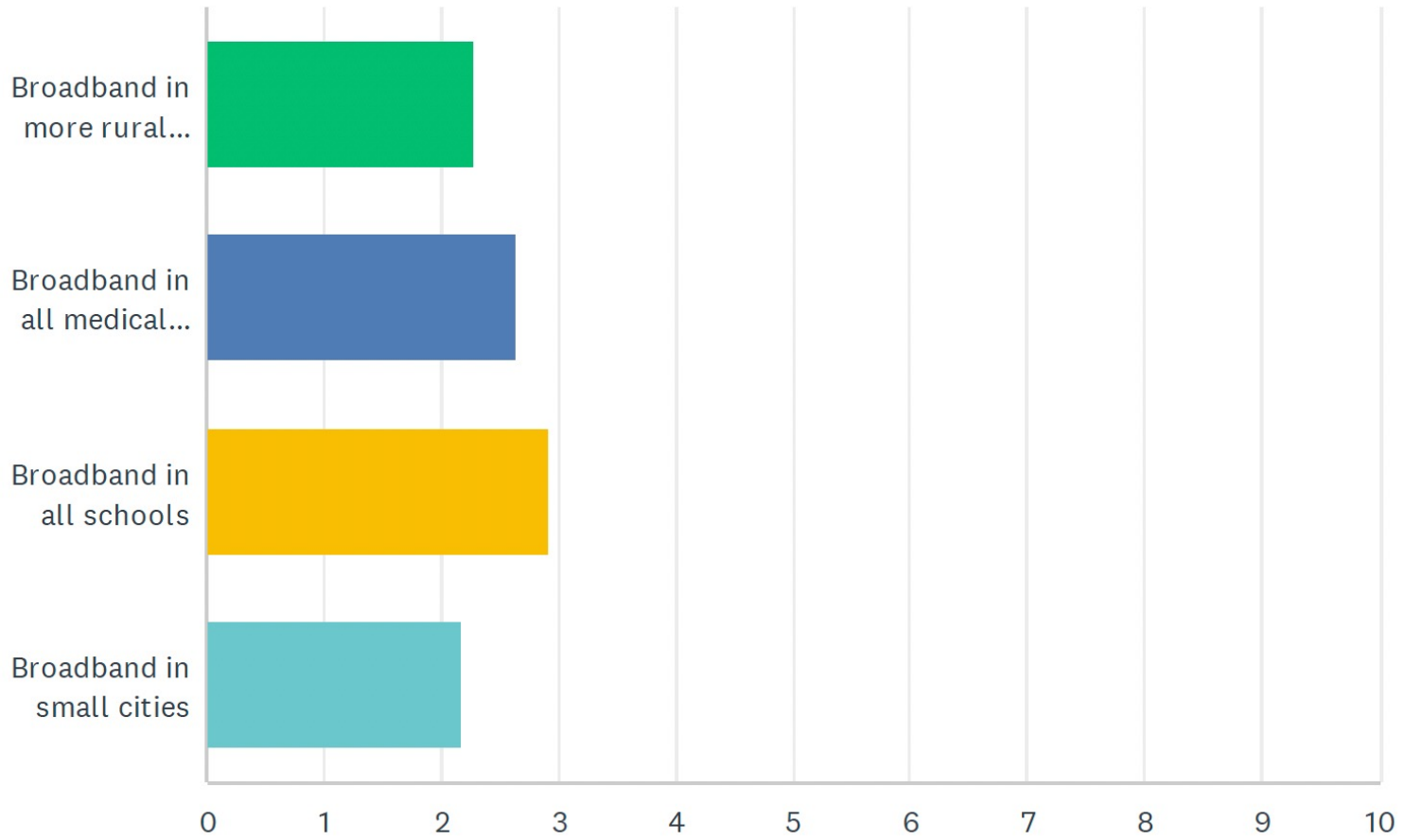

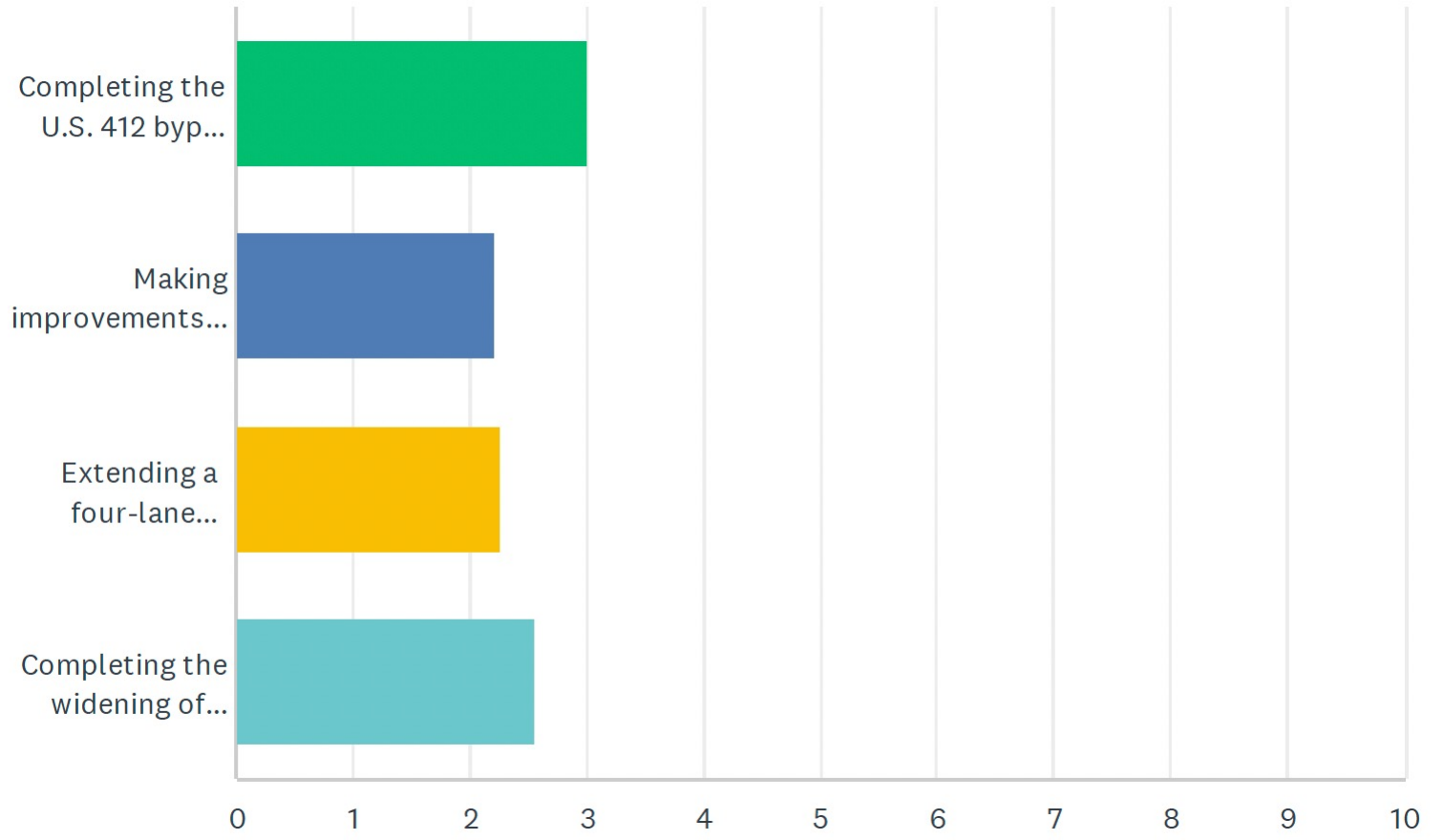

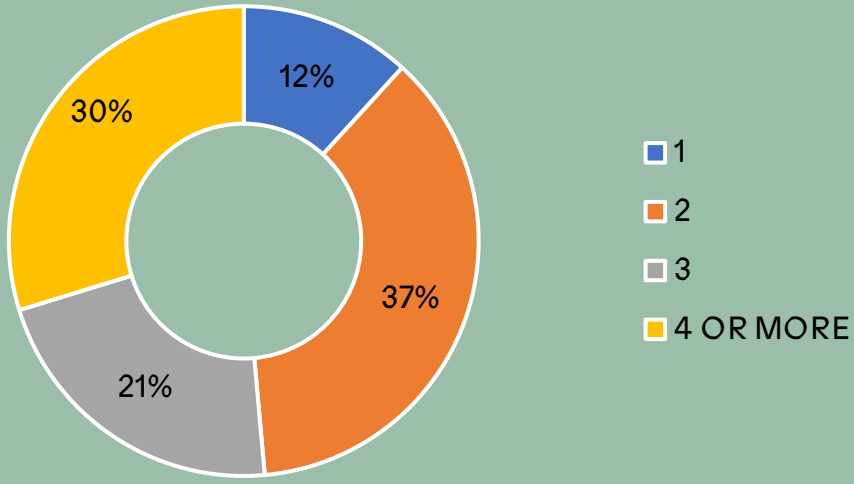

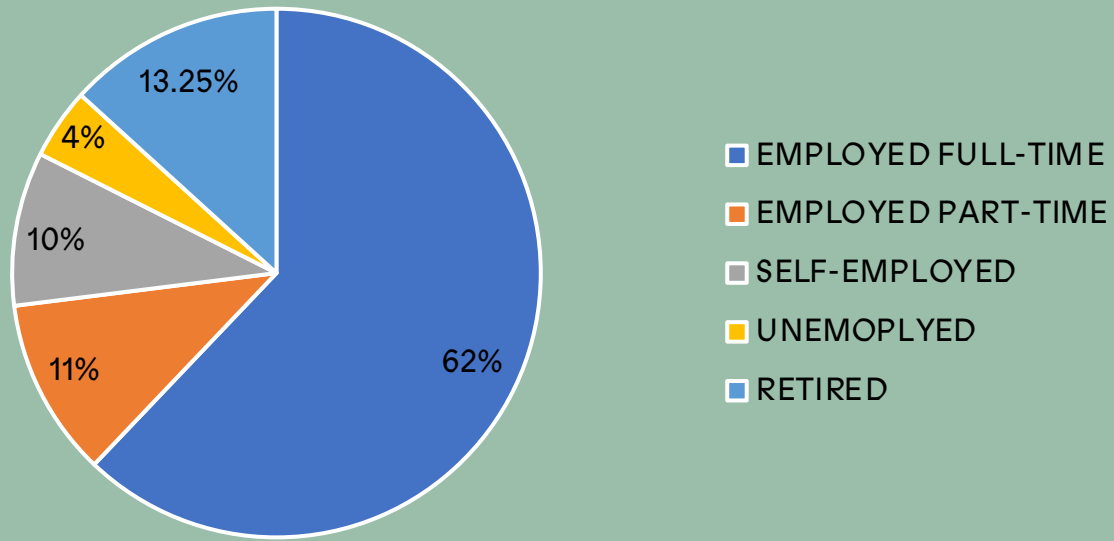
